This whiskey comes from what was the oldest distillery in Scotland, founded in 1772 in the Scottish Lowlands but in a location that took its water from above the famed Highland line. It was also one of the first distilleries to have a woman as an owner, dating back to 1823. Sadly, the distillery closed in 1992, so this whiskey, distilled in 1991 and aged in a bourbon cask for 18 years, will never be re-created. This whiskey is prized for the light smokiness of its taste, common to the whiskeys of the Islands.

Springbank is the oldest family owned distillery in Scotland, having been operated by the Mitchell family since 1828. It is one of the famous Campbelltown distilleries, located in what may have been the first part of Scotland to distill whiskey (having learned about it from the Irish). And this distillery is one of only two in Scotland that handles the distilling and bottling process from start to finish at its distillery site. This unusual whiskey was aged in claret wood, giving it a unique flavor that is quite different from whiskeys aged in the traditional sherry or bourbon casks. The whiskey is known for its clean, clear taste, as a contrast to the smokiness of the Arran. It also has the distinction of being prohibited from export into the United States because, for unknown reasons, the TSA thinks claret wood is a national security threat!
