

ROE V. WADE OVERTURNED

Statement published June 24, 2022

Today, in a single historic moment, the Supreme Court ended the right to abortion access for millions across America. The decision to overturn Roe v. Wade is a devastating blow to fundamental human rights, particularly for individuals who can get pregnant including but not limited to certain cisgender women, transgender men, non-binary individuals — and their partners. We at Woolly are committed to dismantling systems of oppression and are disheartened and infuriated to see one being rebuilt in our country.

We share in the shock, anger, and disappointment that so many are feeling right now.

Please know that this ruling does NOT mean that abortions will be immediately outlawed in the United States. It means that any state now can choose to ban access to abortion.
